## **ORDER**

New Delhi, the----, 2025

- S.O.-----(E).- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 16 read with section 17 and sub-section (3) of section 25 of the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 2016 (11 of 2016), the central Government, after consulting the Bureau of Indian Standards, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do in the public interest, hereby makes the following order, namely:
- **1. Short title and commencement**. (1) This order may be called Fire detection and alarm systems (Quality Control) order, 2025.
- (2) It shall come into force with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette.
- **2.** Compulsory use of Standard Mark. Goods or articles specified in the column (2) of the Table shall conform to the corresponding Indian Standard specified in column (3) of the Table and shall bear the Standard Mark under a license from the Bureau as per Scheme-1 of Schedule-II of the Bureau of Indian Standards (Conformity Assessment) Regulations, 2018 from the date specified in the corresponding entry under column (5) of the Table:

Provided that the Micro enterprises and small enterprises, as defined under the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 (27 of 2006) shall conform to such Indian Standards from the date specified in the corresponding entry under columns (6) and (7) of the Table respectively:

Provided that nothing in this order shall apply to goods or articles manufactured domestically for export.

- **3.** Certification and enforcement authority. The Bureau shall be the certifying and enforcing authority for the goods or articles specified in column (2) of the said Table
- **4. Penalty for contravention.** Any person who contravenes the provisions of this order shall be punishable under the provisions of the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 2016
