S.O.------(E). -- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 read with section 17 and sub-section (3) of section 25 of the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 2016 (11 of 2016), the Central Government, being of the opinion that it is necessary to do so in the public interest, and after consulting the Bureau of Indian Standards, hereby makes the following order, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:- (1) This order may be called the Medical and Surgical Gloves (Quality Control) Order, 2024.

(2) It shall come into force with effect from the _____ day of _____.

2. Application :- It shall apply to goods or articles specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to this order and shall not apply to goods or articles meant for export.

3. Conformity to standard and compulsory use of Standard Mark. - Goods or articles specified in the column (1) of the said schedule shall conform to the corresponding Indian Standard specified in column (2) of the said Schedule and shall bear the Standard Mark under a license from the Bureau of Indian Standards in accordance with Scheme-1 of Schedule-II of the Bureau of Indian Standards (Conformity Assessment) Regulations, 2018.

4. Certification and enforcement authority. - The Bureau of Indian Standards shall be the certifying and enforcing authority in respect of the goods or articles specified in column (1) of the said schedule.
